### ■ Detachable Battery type

- 1) Remove all bags attached to the bicycle.
- 2) Detach the battery from the bicycle and proceed to check-in. (Carry the detached battery and any spare battery as hand luggage.)
- 3) The bicycle, with the battery removed, must pass through an X-RAY scanner during ticketing.
- 4) After the X-RAY scan, ship's crew will move the bicycle outside the scanner area (near the shipside).
- 5) Passengers must proceed to the departure hall and complete immigration procedures.
- 6) After completing immigration, passengers should locate their bicycle outside the X-RAY scanning area and move it onboard (cargo or general area) by themselves.
- 7) Boarding
- 8) Deposit the detached battery at the onboard information desk.
- 9) In case of abnormal signs, the ship crew have a right to dispose of the problematic battery into the sea without the owner's consent.
- 10) Charging bicycle batteries (including spare batteries) onboard without depositing them at the information desk is strongly prohibited.
- 11) Any damages to the ship or surrounding items caused by battery ignition are the responsibility of the bicycle owner.
- 12) Upon disembarkation, follow crew instructions

to use the ramp in the cargo area or gangway.

### ■ Fixed battery type

- 1) Remove all bags attached to the bicycle.
- 2) For bicycles with fixed batteries, check them in without removing the integrated battery.
- 3) Checked-in bicycles must pass through the X-RAY scanner at the ticketing area.
- 4) After the X-RAY scan, ship's crew will move the bicycle outside the scanner area (near the shipside).
- 5) Passengers who have completed the X-RAY screening must proceed to the departure hall for immigration procedures.
- 6) After completing immigration, passengers should retrieve their bicycle from the area outside the X-RAY scanner and move it onboard (cargo area or general area) by themselves.
- 7) Boarding
- 8) In case of abnormal signs, the ship crew have a right to dispose of the problematic bicycle into the sea without the owner's consent.
- 9) Any damages to the ship or surrounding items caused by a fire from the electric bicycle are the responsibility of the bicycle owner.
- 10) Upon disembarkation, follow the crew's instructions to use the ramp in the cargo area or gangway.
